ORDER

The Court has reviewed the proposed official notices and postcard notices submitted by plaintiffs in their Status Report of March 18, 2009. Pursuant to Rule 23(c)(2)(B) of the Rules of the United States Court of Federal Claims, the Court is satisfied that these documents represent “the best notice that is practicable under the circumstances” and meet the specific requirements of subsections (i) through (vii). The official notices and postcard notices are hereby approved for mailing and posting to potential class members, and, in the case of deceased potential class members, their spousal annuitants, children, or parents.
